Can you find examples of different types of metal and write down what they are useful for?

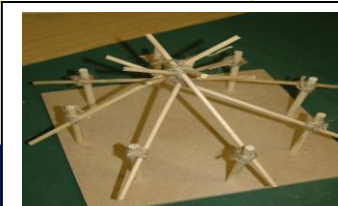


## What was it like living in the iron age?

## AMAZING ARTS

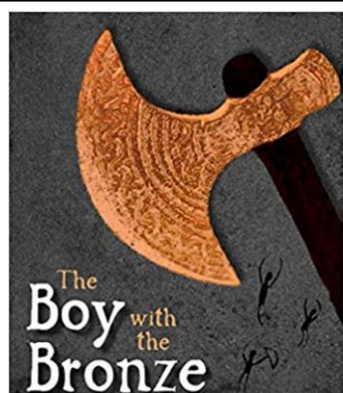
Can you design your own Iron age roundhouse? (This can be drawn, sculpted, made from sticks!)
