ONGOING LEARNING HOMEWORK

Learning homework will be ongoing weekly. In year 4, these will be the following:

- Daily reading
- Weekly spellings (spellings are in Reading record)
- Times tables rockstars (Reading record)
- Bug club (Reading record)
- Practising tricky words (Year 3 and 4 common exception words, attached)
- Regular counting in multiples of: **skill1**; 2, 5, 10, **skill 2**; 3 and 4 **skill 3**; 6, 8, 7, 9 (i.e. counting pairs of socks, clapping in 5s, counting 10p coins)
- Investigating fractions of numbers (i.e. 1/3 of a chocolate bar made of 15 squares)
- Recognising time on an analogue clock (e.g. **skill 1:** recognising o'clock, half past, **skill 2:** quarter past, quarter to and **skill 3:** intervals in between)

Notes and Reminders

- <u>PE</u>: will be on a Monday. Please ensure children have their full PE kit in school which consists of plimsolls, shorts, trousers, T-shirt and a jumper. Please ensure this is in school every day as we sometimes have to swap PE days at short notice. Children who have medium-long hair must have their hair tied back. Earrings need to be removed on this day otherwise they are unable to take part.
- **Reading diaries** are required to be handed in every day. Children are expected to read daily with an adult at home to maximise their development. Please always sign/comment when your child has read so we can monitor and reward when necessary.
- <u>Water bottles</u> need to be brought into school every day to enable the children to have access to fresh water throughout the day. Children are able to refill their bottles during break time and lunchtime.
