ATTENDANCE

Circumstances in which a penalty notice may be issued applies to pupils of statutory school age (SSA). Essex partners have agreed to use penalty notices for the following circumstances (Essex code of Conduct) • Penalty notices for irregular school attendance/unauthorised leave of absence ☐ Penalty notices may be issued where there has been at least 10 sessions of unauthorised absence during the previous ten school weeks. This includes unauthorised late arrivals, coded U, which counts as unauthorised absence for the whole session. In addition to the above criteria, due to the importance of pupils settling into school at the commencement of the school year, penalty notices may also be issued if there have been at least 6 consecutive sessions of unauthorised leave of absence during the first two weeks of September due to a term-time holiday. Discretion will be used to enable up to two penalty notices to be issued to each parent for each child within a twelve month period. If the law continues to be broken around school attendance the Local Authority's legal intervention process will be used.
