HEADTEACHERS MESSAGE

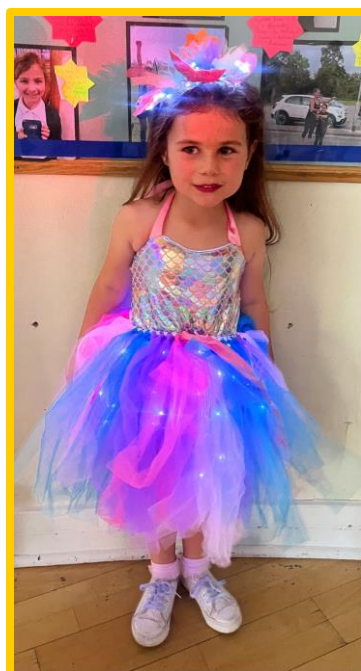
