1. NC	Our intent for R.E follows the purpose of study and the aims of the National Curriculum.

6. Caring	We want our children to demonstrate an understanding and have a tolerance of all different cultures, views and beliefs within the world. We want our children to accept that it is normal for everyone to have different beliefs. We want our children to take an interest in other religions and value them.
7. Human dimension	We want our children to have a good understanding of all other religions and beliefs within the world. We want the children to respect other people's views and beliefs and be sensitive to differences.
